In Korea, there are many children with outstanding Baduk(=Go) strength which can be hardly expected for their ages. Some of them even had great performances in International Children competition, but few participated in competitions as national representatives.

The pressure of the world championship as representative players should be a huge burden to them. Don't you think it is a duty as an adult to let young challengers realize in advance that the world is wide? Or can young challengers go beyond the boundary of the new world?

<How to Play> <TBD>

1. Event form: Blitz game, 5vs5 (foreign players vs Korean young Baduk players)
2. Venue: on the stage in the Closing Ceremony venue, at the hotel
3. Time limit: **10 minutes + Fischer Time 10 seconds**

※If you exceed the time limit, 3 points are given to the opponent as a penalty, and one more Fischer Time is given. From the second time, it should be deemed to lose the match.

4. Handicap: Available if only a kid has lower Baduk strength

※Terrible penalty for the challenged who lose: you should mount the challenger on your shoulders and go around the venue for celebration!
